

## 8 Hidden Facts about Contraception

1. **Attraction is altered:** Hormonal contraception mocks the natural process of pheromones, blocking the ability to recognize the natural attraction of men and women to a complementary life partner.
  - a. Our bodies are naturally designed to be attracted to a partner who will best complement our individual, chemical and hormonal make up. This natural ability is actually blocked by the chemicals in hormonal contraception, potentially causing physical and emotional problems.

4. **Birth Control is an 8 Billion Dollar industry:** in partnership with the Pharmaceutical companies. There is a lot of money to be made introducing the pill to new young women, even to control acne or irregular periods. Also, an effective form of birth control was developed for men, but pharmaceutical companies didn't produce them, knowing men would not subject themselves to the side effects.

7. **Abortifacient:** Hormonal contraception doesn't always stop ovulation. There are 2 back up plans that will attack and destroy life if pregnancy occurs.
  - a. The chemicals thin the uterine lining, making implantation of the embryo almost impossible. This results in the loss of the baby through the woman's menstruation.
  - b. Thickens your cervical mucus, causing a hostile environment for sperm. Sperm are nourished and transported by healthy and fertile cervical mucus.

8. **Studies all over the world:** have shown male fish, otters, and frogs to be affected by the chemicals of hormonal contraception in the water supply, causing them to be androgynous. Think about that!
  - a. The estrogen that the body does not absorb is naturally flushed into the water system, causing havoc with sea life. Britain recorded 1/3 of the fish in their rivers are experiencing sex change due to polluted human sewage.
  - b. Approximately 3% women conceive while on the pill and continue for weeks if not months. Consequently, there is evidence that boy fetuses have some difficulty with male development due to boys getting a lot of estrogen while growing in their system because mother is on the pill.
